Published by Kendall Hunt Publishing, these books are a supplement to private, group or class voice lessons. Though I feel these books can stand alone, they are not meant as a replacement for a good teacher for ensuring student learning sight-singing.

Each book includes the following chapters: Rhythmic Sight-Singing, Intervals, Melodic Sight-Singing and Ear-Training.

Every example in the book includes a track so students may sing along to see if they are sight-singing with accuracy.

I hope these books can be a useful addition to the many teaching tools that already serve to teach young singers in your studio or classroom.
